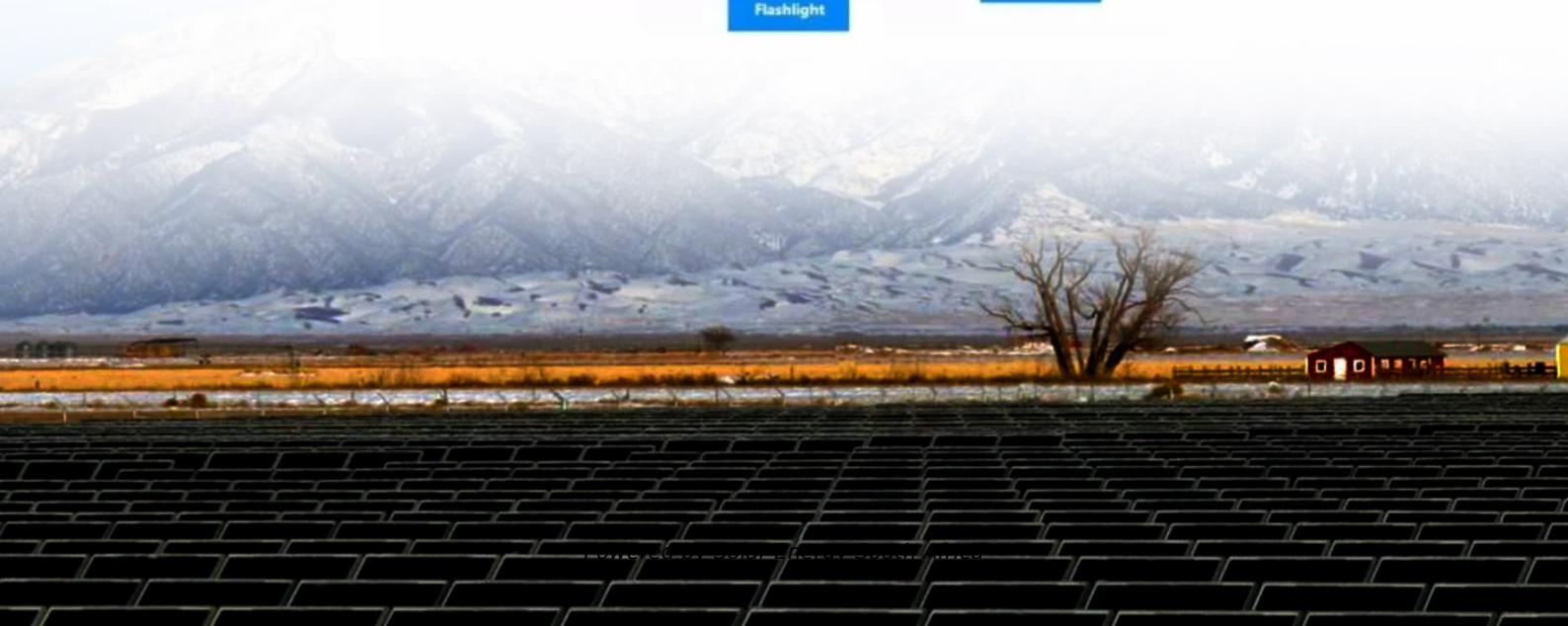

It is not overly difficult to install solar panels. They fit onto a frame and then are fastened into place. However, installing the entire solar array can.

The Goal - Is to find the best location for the array to receive the most sun and the best quality sunlight. That ideal location may be the roof of your house, garage, or barn, or it may be on a.

The basic system is to start with the installation of a rack or platform. If the panels are roof-mounted, a roof racking system is first installed. A ground platform is needed if the panels are ground-mounted, and installing.

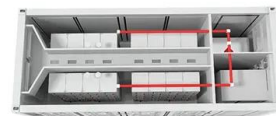
