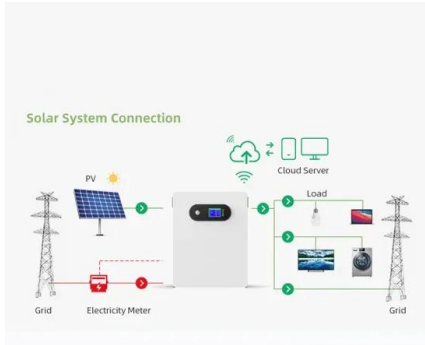

Barbados regulator knocks back utility's 90MW

As of August 2023, there was only 5MW of battery storage connected to the island's grid, all of it utility-owned while renewables generation capacity had hit 87MW. The Barbados government had modelled a need for 204MW of energy storage by 2030 to support its renewable energy goal, with 144MW by 2025.

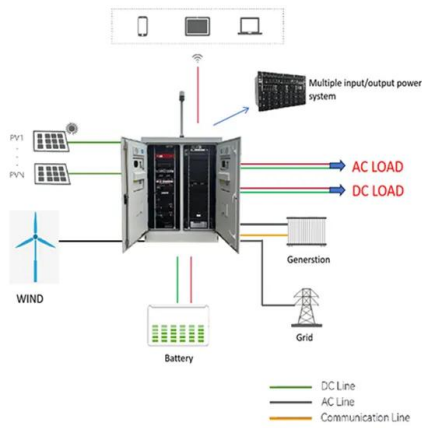
