Overview

Why is Burkina Faso launching a solar power plant in Komsilga?

Loading. In a significant step towards enhancing electricity supply and sustainable development, Burkina Faso signs an agreement for a 50 MWp solar power plant in Komsilga. The initiative, led by the Minister of Energy and Energie Plus, aims to fortify renewable energy contributions, fostering economic growth and improved access to electricity.

Does Burkina Faso have electricity?

Bondukuy and Djigouera are small villages in the south near Bobo-Dioulasso. In the many small villages of Burkina Faso, there is usually no electricity, although every now and then you will see a solar panel or rechargeable car battery running a television or stereo, and you might find an occasional gas-operated refrigerator.

Will a 50 MWp solar power plant bolster Burkina Faso's electricity supply strategy?

In a pivotal move to bolster Burkina Faso's electricity supply strategy, the Minister of Energy, Mines, and Quarries, Simon-Pierre BOUSSIM, and Serge CONSEIGA, General Director of Energie Plus, sealed an agreement for the construction of a 50-megawatt peak (50 MWp) solar power plant in the commune of Komsilga, Burkina Faso.

How has Burkina Faso changed over the years?

Burkina Faso has made remarkable progress in recent years, with an increase in installed capacity from 324.6 megawatts (MW) in 2017 to 410 megawatts in 2019. The share of renewable energy also surged from 9.4% in 2015 to 18.36% in 2019.

How long does a power outage last in Burkina Faso?

The average power outage time was 233 hours in 2018, compared with 172

hours in 2017. In addition, the cost of energy remains high for households and businesses, at XOF 75 per KWh of high-voltage electricity in 2019. No on-grid IPPs operating in Burkina Faso

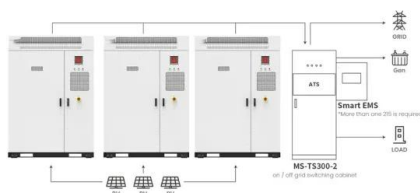
