Do you need planning permission to install solar panels on your roof?

Can solar panels be installed on a house?

Solar photovoltaic (PV) panels can be installed on a wide range of homes. We've heard from people installing solar panels on bungalows and terraces, as well as semi-detached and detached houses. If your main house roof is unsuitable (a thatched roof, for example), solar panels can instead be installed on a garage or other outbuilding.

Should solar panels be installed on a flat roof?

For this reason, solar panels on flat roofs often require planning permission. What's more, the installation should be planned so it minimises the visual impact on the house and local area, as far as possible. And solar panels should be removed if they're no longer in use. Should you install solar panels again if you move home?

Imagining your house filled with mess from a lengthy installation could be enough to put you off considering solar panels. But few owners complained to us about the installation being disruptive, and 80% said that they'd install solar panels again if they moved home.

Are solar panels a legal requirement for new homes?

Even though installing solar panels on new builds is a great way to set new

homes up with renewable energy from day one, it's not yet a legal requirement. One common problem is that developers don't use all the available roof space, resulting in a less effective solar panel system.

Do you own solar panels?

You OWN the solar panels. Under these schemes, you pay for solar panels over a fixed period, say 20 years. There are no upfront costs, and instead you pay a monthly fee, which usually covers the solar panel and battery installation, repairs and maintenance.

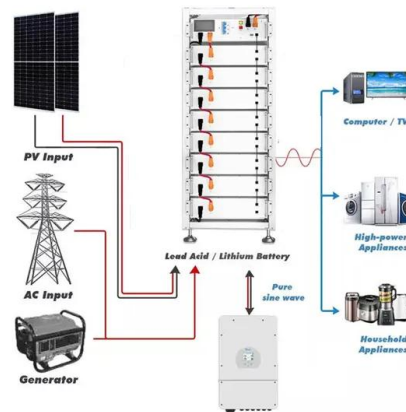

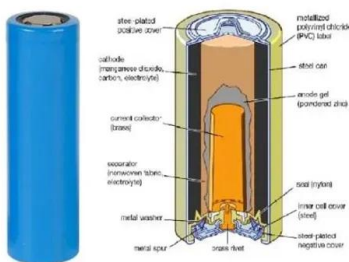

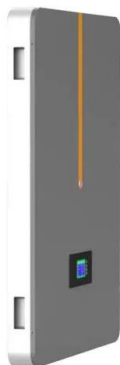
