# Can solar power be installed on the roof



## Overview

Can solar panels be installed on a roof?

"The solar panels will need to be mounted on the roof by installers who understand roofing and will need some scaffold decks to safely get the panels to the roof.

How many solar panels can be installed on a roof?

Your roof will need to be large enough to fit a suitable number of solar panels, as there's rarely much point putting just two or three panels up there. The average solar panel takes up 2m<sup>2</sup>, and your installer should leave around 40cm on each side of the array, as well as 3cm between every panel.

Can a flat roof hold solar panels?

This is because a solar panel system usually weighs about 20kg per square metre, which the great majority of roofs can hold. However, flat roofs may not always be strong enough for solar panels. Drilling into a flat roof can cause leaks, so an installer will usually ballast the panels instead - but these will add around 80kg per panel.

Do solar panels need a sloped roof?

Solar panels are more versatile than you think. You don't necessarily need a sloped roof to benefit from solar energy - you can still install some of the best solar panels on a flat roof and generate enough electricity to power your home.

Can you put solar panels on a slate roof?

You can absolutely put solar panels on slate roofs. It takes more time than most other solar panel installations, and therefore also costs a bit more. But overall, it's still worth it for the hundreds of pounds you can save each year with the solar electricity your panels will generate. Do I need planning permission for solar panels on my roof?

How do you install solar panels on a shingle roof?

Asphalt is perhaps the most popular roof material – as such, asphalt shingle solar panel installations are common and straightforward. Installers will drill studs into your roof and attach panel mounts at those locations.

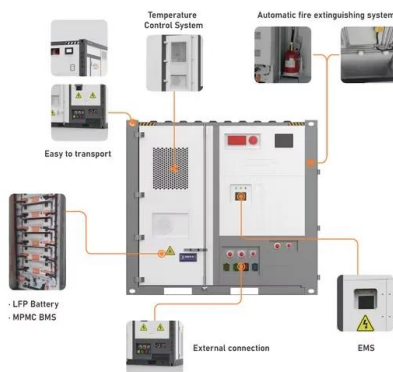
