Overview

What is happening in Central African Republic?

Since gaining independence in 1960, the Central African Republic has experienced a series of crises and conflicts, violence and instability. Attempted and successful coups d'état have followed one another. The presence of rebels has become a ubiquitous phenomenon in many parts of the country.

What are the natural resources of Central African Republic (CAR)?

The Central African Republic (CAR), a landlocked country in the center of Africa, possesses abundant natural and mineral resources such as gold, diamonds, uranium, phosphates, nickel, cobalt, copper and coltan. However, despite these resources, the country remains one of the poorest and most fragile in the world.

What happened to the Central African Republic after Bokassa?

After BOKASSA's departure, the country's name once again became the Central African Republic. CAR's fifth coup in 2013 unseated President Francois BOZIZE after the Seleka, a mainly Muslim rebel coalition, seized the capital and forced BOZIZE to flee the country.

Does Central African Republic have a military?

The Central African Republic maintains a small military, which includes army, air force, and paramilitary forces. French troops were withdrawn from the country in 1997 and were replaced by contingents sent by the United Nations Mission in the Central African Republic (Mission des Nations Unies en République Centrafricaine; MINURCA).

The Central African Republic (CAR) is a perennially weak state that sits at the crossroads of ethnic and linguistic groups in the center of the African

continent.

When did the Central African Republic become part of France?

Some key dates in the history of the Central African Republic: 1880s - France annexes the area, partitions it among commercial concessionaires. 1894 - France sets up a dependency in the area called Ubangi-Chari and partitions it among commercial concessionaires. 1910 - Ubangi-Chari becomes part of the Federation of French Equatorial Africa.

In May 2022, the government implemented a voluntary effort to repatriate 6,000 Central African refugees who fled to the Democratic Republic of the Congo as part of a tripartite agreement in 2019. A total of 218 persons, mainly from Cameroon and the Democratic

Republic of the Congo, were returned between January and March. f.
