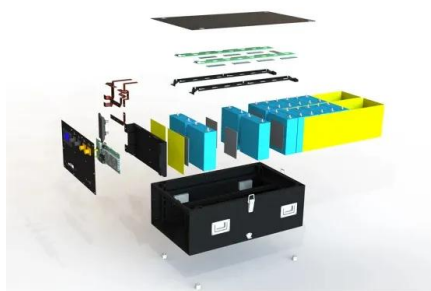
## Covanta Hempstead , NON-Biogenic Municipal Solid Waste

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Covanta Hempstead is ranked #2 out of 59 non-biogenic municipal solid waste power plants nationwide in terms of total annual net electricity generation.. Covanta Hempstead is comprised of 1 generator and generated 156.1 GWh during the 3-month period between June 2024 to September 2024.

## Dewatering Submersible Pumps

The Covanta Dade energy plant in Florida processes 4,200 tons of municipal solid waste and biomass fuel daily. The plant burns that waste to produce electricity, boiling water to turn turbines that generate 77 megawatts of power. During the boiler blowout procedure, 185°F water is pumped from the system to minimize buildup of scale and



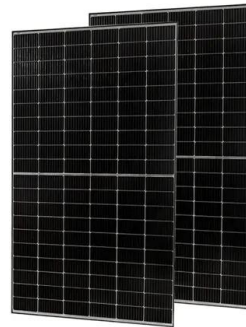
## H Power

## Covanta Huntsville WTE Facility , Huntsville, AL

The Huntsville Solid Waste-to-Energy Facility, operating as Covanta Huntsville, Inc., is located on 20.5 acres adjacent to Redstone Arsenal in Huntsville, AL. Covanta Huntsville began



commercial operation in July 1990. The facility processes 690 tons per day of solid waste and sewage sludge from the Huntsville wastewater treatment plant.

## Dublin Waste To Energy Plant, Ireland
