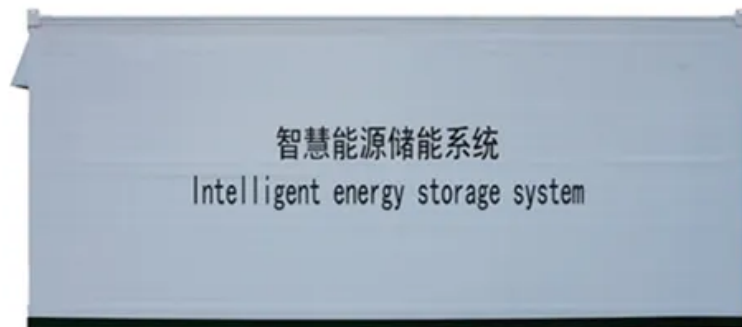

Overview

What happened to Cuba's power plant?

The situation came to a head on Friday, when Cuba's largest power plant malfunctioned, joining several smaller plants already offline. Foul weather had also stalled the arrival of fuel from tanker ships offshore, starving the island's power plants. The combination prompted the entire grid to collapse.

Why is the Cuban electric power system losing its operations?

The so-called thermal generation is the basis of the Cuban Electric Power System, but it suffers from the handicap of an aging and overexploited infrastructure. In addition, it has been losing part of its operations, following the withdrawal of the Mariel, Renté, Nuevitas units and the historic Tallapiedra plant in Havana.

How will sanctions affect Cuba's electric power system?

The real impact of the sanctions on the island's Electric Power System cannot be minimized. The damage to this sector, between March 2023 and February of this year, amounted to 388,239,830 dollars, according to official estimates from Cuba.

Does Cuba need a solar power system?

It has historically relied on allies like Venezuela and Russia for cheaper fuel supplies. Cuba has been working on a project to upgrade the island's electrical grid through the use of alternative power sources. The construction of 31 centers to generate solar energy is under way and expected to be completed next year.

How does Cuba get its power?

Cuba gets its power from large thermoelectric plants like Antonio Guiteras and some smaller ones, which run on crude oil. While the island produces about half of its own crude oil, it must import the remainder, which can be difficult —

and costly — due to U.S. sanctions.

Why is there a power outage in Cuba?

Cuba's power grid has been plagued by frequent outages in recent months, with more than half of the country experiencing power cuts during peak hours. The outages are primarily caused by fuel shortages and aging infrastructure. In many parts of the island, electricity is crucial for cooking and water pumping.

informed that the power plant had been deteriorating for the past few decades and it is not the only one in the country under those concerning circumstances.

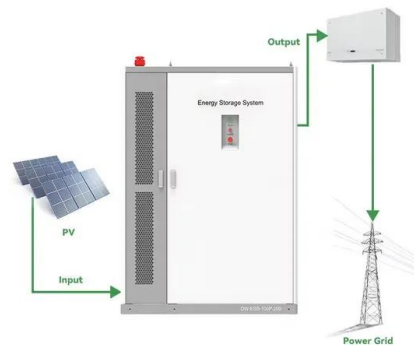


Why Are Power Outages Worsening in Cuba?

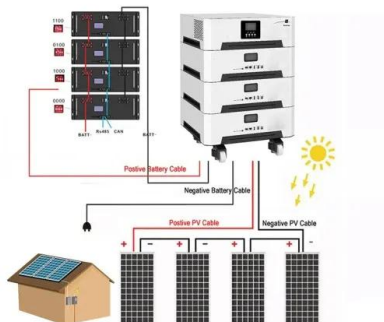
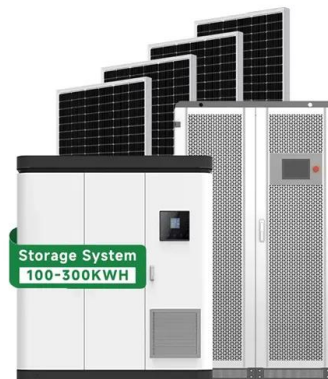

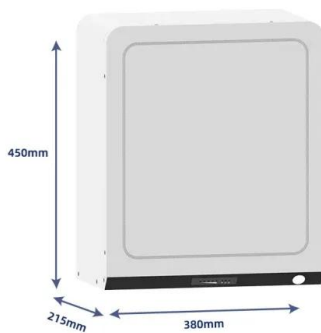


With Few Exceptions, Cuba Remains in Darkness Despite Effort to ...

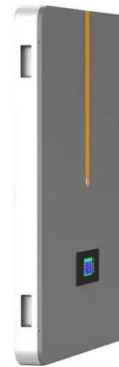
