How do humans use wind energy?

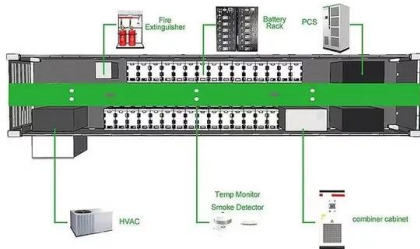

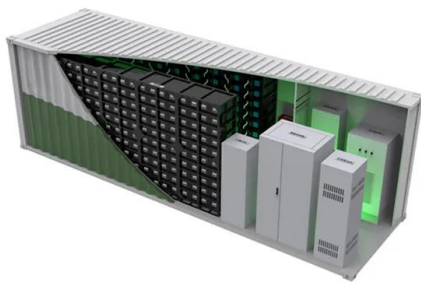
