Overview

Électricité de Tahiti (EDT) is an electricity company which holds the public concession for the generation and distribution of electricity in . In 2022 it was ranked as the largest company in French Polynesia by turnover. It is 70% owned by the group, with the , itself a subsidiary of Engie, holding a further 21%. The company produces thermal and renewable electricity, operates the transmission network o.

Who created the first electricity company in French Polynesia?

The first public electrical energy distribution company in French Polynesia was created in 1910 by Charles Ducorron. It was succeeded by the Etablissements Martin et fils, who held the concession for providing electricity in Tahiti.

How many gas stations are there in French Polynesia?

Until 2006, our strategy focused essentially on the development and consolidation of our position in French Polynesia, in Tahiti, but also in the outer islands. Leader on the market, our network has 14 gas stations today, in 4 islands (Tahiti, Moorea, Raiatea and Rangiroa).

Does EDT provide electricity to other islands in French Polynesia?

In return, EDT was required to extend its services to other islands in French Polynesia, without a price increase. EDT thus ensures the production and supply of electricity in Tahiti as well as in nineteen other islands and towns in French Polynesia.

What is French Polynesia's energy transition plan?

French Polynesia's energy transition plan has three main objectives: Change the energy model, by gradually replacing the use of fossil fuels with renewable energies in all activities.

What was the first gas station in French Polynesia?

Albert Moux and Shell Pacific Co. merge and create Polypétroles & Shell in French Polynesia. 1988 : The storage challenge Construction of the first land

based fuel storage depot in Tahiti (French Polynesia), with a capacity of 33,150 million litres, inaugurated in December 1989. 1990: First gas station in French Polynesia.

Why are electricity prices higher in French Polynesia than in mainland France?

Electricity prices in French Polynesia are higher than in mainland France, due in particular to costs made higher by the remoteness and fragmentation of the electricity system, as well as by the absence of nuclear energy.

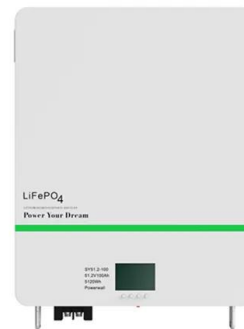


Supporting French Polynesia's energy transition

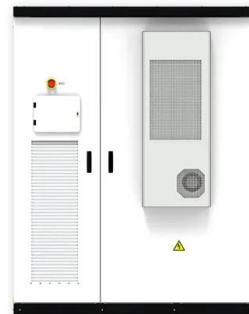
