Overview

How do I size a generator?

When sizing a generator it is important to take into consideration the running loads and the starting currents. For example, the running current of a 3 phase 10 HP induction motor will be approximately 13 Amps, however the starting current will be between 3 and 9 times the running current i.e. 39 to 117 Amps.

How much space should a generator have?

I would suggest that you have a clear 6 feet space all the way around each of the generators. That way you would have heat exchange and fresh air flow from the vents. Plus the 6 ft would give maintenance enough room to work or a forklift to pick up to remove. Where you mount the disconnects will make a difference too.

How big should a generator room be?

Dadw5boys recommended 6ft around each generator to allow for maintenance and forklifts. You will need to find out how much room is available to you for the generator room addition in order to design a proper layout of the room. You wouldn't want to design a room larger than the space allocated for it.

How much airflow should a gen set have?

The ventilation system should sufficiently move air to control temperature in all areas of the engine room. The following equations provide the proper airflow (cfm or m³/s velocity for a given gen set installation, assuming 100 F (38C) ambient temperature: Airflow (cfm or m³/s should increase 10 percent for every 2,500 feet (760m) above sea level.

Does a generator need ventilation?

Large generators, configured with an air inlet positioned high on the

generator, will require an additional source of ventilation air. If Ventilation Type 1 or Type 2 is not feasible, an alternative is Type 3; however, this routing configuration will require approximately 50% more airflow than Type 1.

Does a generator intake need cool air?

It is important to note that cooling air is needed for more than just the engine; the generator intake also requires cool clean air. The most effective way to do this is to provide a ventilation air source low to the ground at the rear of the package.
