How many years will it take for photovoltaic panels to become obsolete



Overview

After about 25-30 years it's typically more cost effective to replace them with new ones. Experts say billions of panels will eventually all need to be disposed of and replaced. Can solar PV panels be repurposed by 2050?

This report is the first-ever projection of PV panel waste volumes to 2050. It highlights that recycling or repurposing solar PV panels at the end of their roughly 30-year lifetime can unlock an estimated stock of 78 million tonnes of raw materials and other valuable components globally by 2050.

Will solar PV produce end-of-life waste in 2050?

Projected generation of end-of-life waste from solar PV panels between 2030 and 2050 (International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), 2016). Foreseeing the countries producing the highest amount of solar PV EOL waste is challenging.

Should solar panels be repurposed at the end of life?

The report, End-of-Life Management: Solar Photovoltaic Panels, is the first-ever projection of PV panel waste volumes to 2050 and highlights that recycling or repurposing solar PV panels at the end of their roughly 30-year lifetime can unlock a large stock of raw materials and other valuable components.

How long do solar panels last?

Are obsolete photovoltaic panels sustainable?

While the sustainable management of obsolete photovoltaic panels would be influenced by the lack of accurate data on the waste flow of each PV consumer country, only about 16% of studies related to specific countries have attempted to estimate their EoL PV waste streams.

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Photovoltaic (PV) Solar Panels

Under typical UK conditions, 1m² of PV panel will produce around 100kWh electricity per year, so it would take around 2.5 years to "pay back" the energy cost of the panel. PV panels have an expected life of least 25 to 30 years, so ...

End of life analysis of solar photovoltaic panel: ...

Generally, producers suggest that the useful life of a solar panel is approximately 25 to 30 years. On the other hand, according to some studies, the useful life of the panel can be longer (Kadro and Hagfeldt, 2017).
