How to identify unqualified photovoltaic panels



Overview

Are solar PV installations notifiable?

To clarify, what is certain is that nearly all domestic electrical work is notifiable under Part P of the Building Regulations (see below) and a solar PV installation is nearly always notifiable electrical work.

Should a PV system be isolated before electrical work is performed?

A PV system is an additional source of supply, so both the mains supply and the PV supply must be securely isolated before electrical work is performed on the installation.

What is the seaward Guide to solar PV Testing?

The Seaward Guide to Solar PV Testing seeks to offer guidance to PV system technicians and engineers to identify exactly what electrical testing is needed to fulfil their obligations to the customer and also to satisfy the various industry standards (including NABCEP) and best working practices available.

What are the new requirements for labeling solar PV systems?

The requirements in 690.56 (C) for the labeling of buildings with PV systems and “Rapid Shutdown” have been modified to reflect the delayed implementation date of January 1, 2019, that appeared in the 2017 NEC. The labels will now read as follows: “SOLAR PV SYSTEM IS EQUIPPED WITH RAPID SHUTDOWN.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you’ve earned with your system – so there’s absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don’t meet building regulations. It’s crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

What is a solar PV installation?

The confusion comes in as a solar PV installation is often much more than electrical work, for example some installations involve major roofing work and other structural changes especially when integrating photovoltaics into a building's fabric. This work goes beyond Part P and electrical installations, we are now talking about building work.

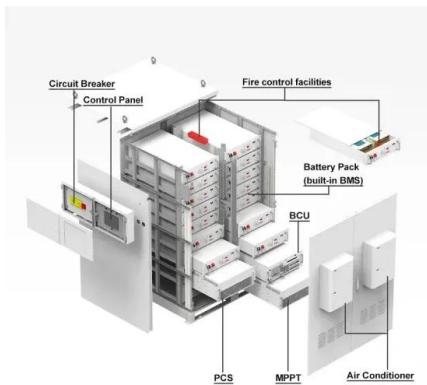

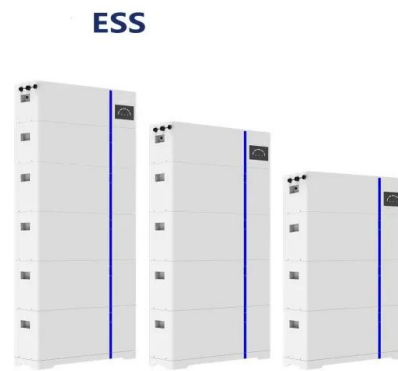
