How to use solar energy to generate electricity at night



Overview

Can 'night-time' solar power produce electricity?

UNSW researchers have made a major breakthrough in renewable energy technology by producing electricity from so-called 'night-time' solar power. The team from the School of Photovoltaic and Renewable Energy Engineering generated electricity from heat radiated as infrared light, in the same way as the Earth cools by radiating into space at night.

Why should you use solar energy at night?

Utilising stored solar energy at night offers several advantages. It ensures an uninterrupted power supply, critical for maintaining comfort and security. It also reduces dependence on the electricity grid, leading to potential cost savings on energy bills.

Can a solar system provide nighttime standby lighting and power?

"Our approach can provide nighttime standby lighting and power in off-grid and mini-grid applications, where [solar] cell installations are gaining popularity," the study said. Mini-grid applications refer to independent electricity networks. These can be used when a population is too small or too far away to extend the grid.

Do solar panels convert sunlight into electricity?

Quite frankly, no -- solar panels work only when there's sunlight to convert into electricity. Even on nights with strong moonlight or starlight, these illumination sources won't make a difference. Whether they're installed for residential or commercial use, solar panels only convert direct and indirect sunlight.
