Can solar panels be wired in parallel?

In the U.S., solar strings are required to feature a maximum voltage of 600V, so solar arrays comply with article 690 section 7 of the National Electrical Code (NEC 690.7). Wiring solar panels in parallel increases the output current, while keeping the voltage constant.
