Overview

How do I write a short film?

The first step in creating your own short film is figuring out what you want to write about. A brainstorming session can help you get all your ideas out and see what resonates. You might want to explore some writing prompts like: What have been the most pivotal moments in your adult life?

What defining events can you remember from your childhood?

What are the rules for writing short films?

These short movies vary in genre and style. They're all effective. As you can see, the rules for writing short films are all on display in these examples. They keep it simple, the premises are unique, the genres identifiable, and the stories have a beginning, middle, and end. They're also all short films: no 40-minute monsters here.

How long is a short film?

That said, the average length of short films is about 20 minutes. Most filmmakers keep their short films to an absolute maximum of 50 minutes (but that's on the long side). Just like feature films, short films are complete stories with a beginning, middle and end. The main difference is that they're, well, a lot shorter.

Should you write a short film script?

But many a drawer is littered with short film scripts that will never see the light of day, much less the light of a Kino. Writing a short film can be a lesson in filmmaking, but it can also be a calling card for finding representation or financing. So how do you write a great short film?

What makes a short script different from a feature?

Can a short film be a proof of concept?

Successful short films can act as a proof of concept for a larger project, enabling the screenwriter or director to secure cash for a full-length feature film or TV show. Just ask Damien Chazelle, whose movie *Whiplash* started as a short film and went on to pick up tonnes of awards.

How long should a short film script be?

In screenwriting, one page of your script is usually equivalent to one minute of screentime. So if you're looking to make an average, 20-minute long short film, you'll want your short film script to be about 20 pages long. New to the scriptwriting game?

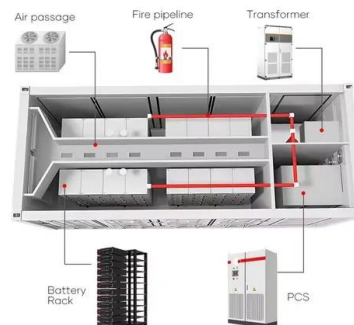
