Overview

What does Iraq's President want the world to know?

BAGHDAD (AP) — Nearly 20 years after the overthrow of Saddam Hussein by U.S.-led forces, Iraqi President Abdul Latif Rashid wants the world to know his country now is at peace, democratic and intent on rebuilding economic life while maintaining a government that serves the whole country and the region.

Are Iraqis doing better than 20 years ago?

Still by a number of indicators, Iraqis today are doing better than 20 years ago. As far as democracy goes, since the 2003 invasion there have been six elections, eight different governments and seven different prime ministers.

Is Iraq ready to improve everyday life?

Rashid told The Associated Press on Sunday that after overcoming the hardships of the past two decades, Iraq is ready to focus on improving everyday life for its people.

Is Iraq a democracy?

But since assuming office in October 2022, Sudani has sought to balance Iraq's relations with Iran and Arab countries. Despite some progress, Iraq is not quite a democracy, it is vulnerable to the machinations of its neighbors, and it remains wracked with political, economic, and social problems.

How do Iraqis feel about the former regime?

Thus their responses do not realistically reflect their opinion of the former regime as much as their discontent with the current situation. The current figures indicate Iraqis' clear frustration and disappointment with the regime and mode of governance in Iraq.

Does Iraq have a government?

Iraq has held elections regularly since January 2005, it has a parliament that, despite significant cleavages, functions as more than a rubber stamp for the government, and there have been peaceful transfers of power from government to government.

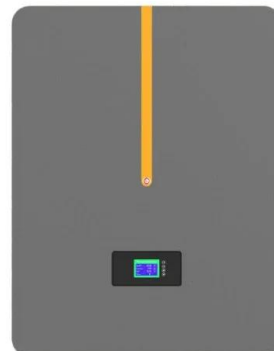

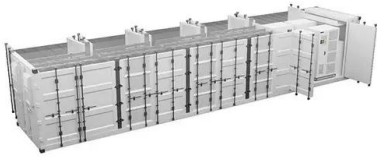

In post-2003 Iraq, the three tools of social power have been vividly at play in the context of vertical relations and public action. To maintain social power through the social contract, leaders have relied in part on ideological appeals: to ethno-sectarianism, support for democracy, opposition to dictatorship, civic spirit and reformism.

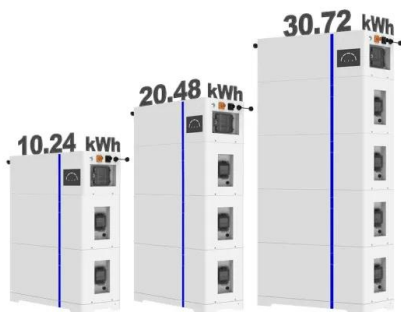

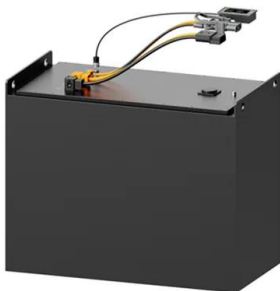

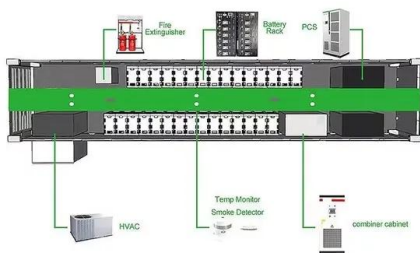
