Are solar panels legal?

However, it's crucial to understand that while installing solar panels is legal, certain conditions must be met. For most domestic properties, solar panel installations are considered a "permitted development" and do not require planning permission, provided they respect certain size criteria.

Can I install solar panels without planning permission?

If you live in a house with permitted development rights you can install solar panels without planning permission, subject to certain conditions and limitations. These rights may vary based on location and property type, so you must check with your local planning authority.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system – so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

Are solar panels legal in the UK?

All electrical work in the UK must comply with the national standard, BS 7671. Therefore, it's not just about the legality but also the safety and reliability of your solar panel system. While the Feed-in Tariff (FIT) scheme has concluded for new applicants, those already part of it continue to benefit from the incentive.

Are solar panels safe?

Safety regulations should be followed during the installation process, including proper handling of electrical components and ensuring the safety. Check with your home insurance provider to ensure that your solar panel system is adequately covered in case of damage or other unforeseen events.

Do I need a building regulations certificate for my solar panel system?

You should receive a building regulations certificate, known as a completion certificate, for your solar panel system. This certificate will assure you and any future owners that the work met all building regulations, which will make it much easier to sell your property at any point.
