Is it illegal to install solar power generators



Overview

A do-it-yourself solar panel installation is not illegal. You'll typically not need planning permission to install solar panels on the roof of your residential property. Is it legal to install solar panels?

It is legal to install your solar panels; however, you must adhere to all building and electrical regulations, which might necessitate professional certification and can affect eligibility for incentive schemes. What happened to the Feed-in Tariff (FIT) scheme?

Do I need permission to install solar panels?

Nevertheless, if your building is listed or located in a conservation area, you will need to seek specific permissions. It's paramount that any solar panel installation is carried out by the Microgeneration Certification Scheme (MCS).

Can You Power Your House with a solar generator?

You could, in theory, power your house with a solar generator, but its capacity must match your household's energy needs. Larger solar generators, coupled with enough battery storage, can handle multiple appliances and systems. However, if you want constant power for your whole house, a complete solar panel system is usually your best bet.

Can I use my solar panels if I'm not at home?

Additionally, even though your solar panels will generate electricity, it is unlikely to all be used by yourself. The sun is obviously only out during the day, so if you are not at home, it will be fed into the grid so that it can be used by somebody else.

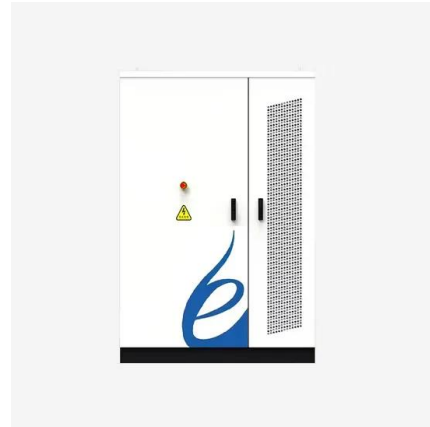
