The Sun generates radiant energy that it gives off as heat and light. The light of the Sun travels the 147 million kilometres to Earth in just over 8 minutes. Does solar power use heat and light?

Confusion over the impact of heat and light in solar power starts with the fact that there are different types of solar power. One type of power, called solar thermal, does use the sun's light to generate heat which can be used for things such as household hot water or to generate steam to drive turbines and generate electricity.

What is solar energy?

solar energy, radiation from the Sun capable of producing heat, causing chemical reactions, or generating electricity. The total amount of solar energy incident on Earth is vastly in excess of the world's current and anticipated energy requirements.

How does solar energy work?

Solar energy is constantly flowing away from the sun and throughout the solar system. Solar energy warms Earth, causes wind and weather, and sustains plant and animal life. The energy, heat, and light from the sun flow away in the form of electromagnetic radiation (EMR).

Do solar panels generate electricity at night?

Solar panels generate no electricity at night time. Solar panels can't store energy, so you have to use the electricity they generate when the sun is shining. You need batteries to store the energy generated. These are expensive. - Solar cells convert the light from the sun into electricity.

Can solar panels generate electricity?

Yes, it can – solar power only requires some level of daylight in order to harness the sun's energy. That said, the rate at which solar panels generate electricity does vary depending on the amount of direct sunlight and the quality, size, number and location of panels in use.

Can solar energy be used as a thermal energy source?

Solar energy has long been used directly as a source of thermal energy. Beginning in the 20th century, technological advances have increased the number of uses and applications of the Sun's thermal energy and opened the doors for the generation of solar power.

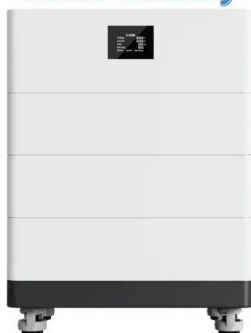
