Is Kosovo a candidate for EU accession?

Kosovo is a potential candidate for EU accession. It unilaterally declared its independence in February 2008. All but five Member States (Cyprus, Greece, Romania, Slovakia and Spain) have recognised Kosovo's independence. In the region, Serbia and Bosnia and Herzegovina have not recognised Kosovo.

Is Kosovo a member of the EU?

As confirmed by the Thessaloniki Summit in June 2003, Kosovo is firmly anchored in the framework of the Stabilisation and Association Process (SAP), the EU policy which applies to the Western Balkans which is designed to prepare potential candidates for membership.

Why does the European Union call Kosovo a 'Kosovo'?

As a result, the European Union itself refers only to "Kosovo", with an asterisked footnote containing the text agreed to by the Belgrade–Pristina negotiations: "This designation is without prejudice to positions on status, and is in line with UNSCR 1244 and the ICJ Opinion on the Kosovo Declaration of Independence."
