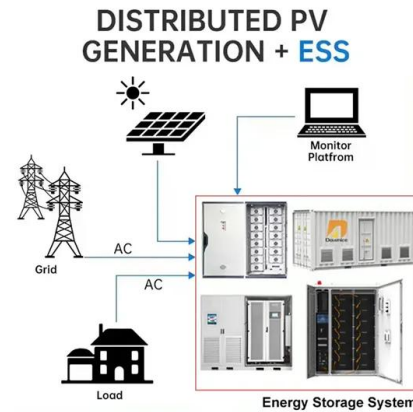


How a "portfolio approach" sparked a blue and green shift in Mauritius ...

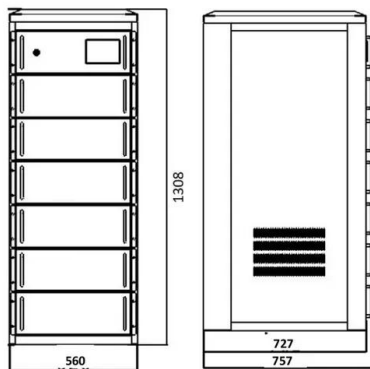
