Overview

What energy sources are used in New Zealand?

Electrical energy in New Zealand is mainly derived from renewable energy sources such as from hydropower, geothermal power and wind energy. The large share of renewable energy sources makes New Zealand one of the most sustainable countries in terms of energy generation.

How does New Zealand generate electricity?

New Zealand's electricity is mostly generated through renewable sources such as hydro and geothermal energy. Our renewable generation is supplemented by thermal 'peaker' plants when demand is high or during dry periods when hydro stores are low.

Who buys electricity in New Zealand?

Retail companies buy electricity from generators and on-sell that electricity to businesses and households across New Zealand. For most New Zealand electricity customers, there's a lot of retailers and brands to buy electricity from. The latest retail market share, market competitiveness and switching trends.

Which sector uses the most stationary energy in New Zealand?

The dairy product manufacturing sector is the largest stationary energy using sector in New Zealand, accounting for around 18% of all industrial stationary energy use in 2022. Coal consumption has been decreasing year on year since 2018 and fossil gas consumption has been decreasing year on year since 2019.

What is New Zealand's domestic energy supply?

Since the closure of New Zealand's only oil refinery at Marsden Point, all domestic petroleum needs are served by imports of refined products such as petrol, diesel, and jet fuel. Domestic energy supply is derived from either

indigenous production or imported from overseas sources.

Which sector consumes the most energy in New Zealand?

The industrial and transport sectors together comprise two-thirds of New Zealand's energy consumption. In 2022, the domestic transport sector accounted for 37.4% (202.9 PJ) of the energy consumed, while the industrial sector accounted for a further 31.5% (170.9 PJ).
