Planting *Acorus calamus* under photovoltaic panels



Overview

If located outside of USDA hardiness zones 4 – 11, you may need to bring your plant indoors for winter. The foliage of *Acorus calamus* are not hardy to frosty conditions and will naturally die back. The rootstock and rhizomes enter a resting phase and should be protected with a layer of mulch if left outdoors. Pots that are.

Can *Acorus calamus* grow in water?

Acorus calamus is a perfect grass-like plant for your water feature's marginal or edge sections. Its roots and leaves are well-adjusted to sitting in shallow water or consistently wet soil as it is normally found in wetlands.

What is *Acorus calamus* variegatus?

One of the most popular cultivars of this species is *Acorus calamus* 'Variegatus' or variegated sweet flag. This plant has striking green leaves that gracefully arch and can grow to a length of 5 feet (152 cm)! Each leaf is marked with a cream-colored longitudinally-oriented stripe.

How do you care for *Acorus calamus*?

The *Acorus calamus* is a pretty simple plant to care for, but it does require moderation. In other words, it does not do well when exposed to extreme temperatures or constantly changing levels of water and pH. Sweet flag propagation is fairly easy once it is established in its environment.

How do you plant *Acorus*?

Plant Acorus in full sun or partial shade. Plant Acorus in constantly moist or wet soil that is rich in organic matter. Acorus will grow in standing water. Set Acorus outdoors in the garden in spring or autumn. Space Acorus 6 to 24 inches (15-60cm) apart. Acorus want wet or very moist soil. Acorus thrives in shallow standing water.

Can Acorus grow in a pot?

Acorus add a grassy texture and nice color to container gardens. Plant them alone in a pot or mix them with other plants that have similar soil moisture and sun needs. Some varieties appreciate a drier soil while others like a consistently moist or boggy soil. Most like part shade however some will tolerate full to mostly sun.

What does Acorus calamus smell like?

The leaves grow to approximately 16 inches in length by 3-4 inches in width and are a light green color with a hint of yellow. The rootstock of this plant is highly aromatic and holds a unique, sweet smell. The Acorus calamus is a plant native to the wetlands of India, China, Thailand, and other warm climates.
