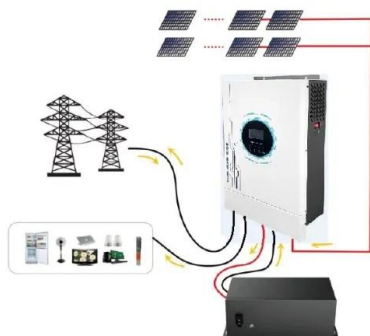


History of the Falkland Islands

In 1833, the British returned to the Falkland Islands. Argentina invaded the islands on 2 April 1982. The British responded with an expeditionary force that forced the Argentines to surrender. 1776 the British forces under the command of Royal Naval Lieutenant Clayton formally left Port Egmont, while leaving a plaque asserting Britain's

According to my copy of Martin Middlebrook's The Falklands War: . The plaque was later removed by a Spanish naval officer and taken to Buenos Aires. Since he says 'Spanish' and not 'Argentinian' I presumed the plaque was removed sometime before 1811 when the Spanish settlements in the Malvinas were withdrawn.

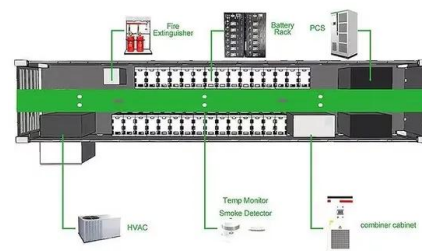

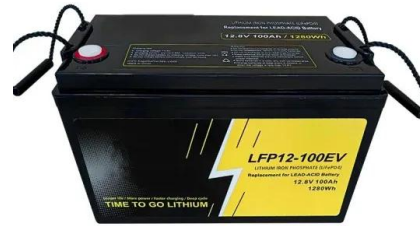

The principal islands are about 300 miles (483 kilometres) east of South America's southern Patagonian coast, and about 752 miles (1,210 kilometres) from the northern tip of the Antarctic Peninsula, at a latitude of about 52°S.

Plaque, Stanley, Falkland Islands

Plaque, Stanley, Falkland Islands. Marines (as they were known prior to 1802) first landed in the Falkland Islands in January 1765, as part of Captain Byron's Surveying Expedition. A subsequent expedition under Captain McBride, included 25 Marines and landed at Port Egmont, Saunders Island, in January 1766. The graves of those who died there are close to the settlement.
