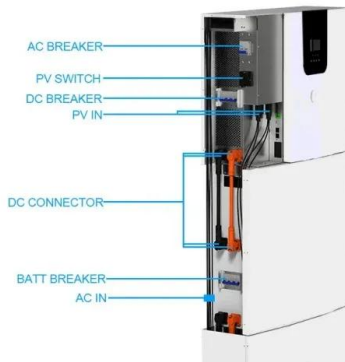

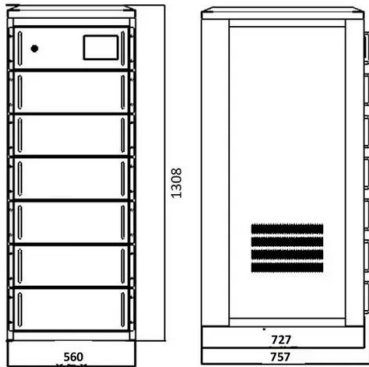
Chinese players respond to EU EV tariffs

On the 5 th of July, the EU's provisional tariffs on Chinese-made EVs came into force at a slightly reduced rate compared to the tariffs announced on the 12 th of June. Some automakers, such as SAIC, now face import tariffs of up to 47.6%. With tariffs now ranging between 27.4% and 47.6% the reaction amongst Chinese players has differed.
