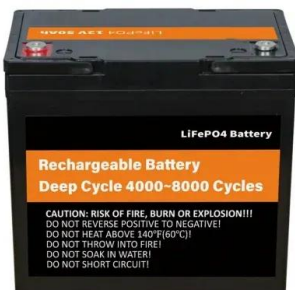


Budget 2025: A Critical Moment for Ireland's Solar Future

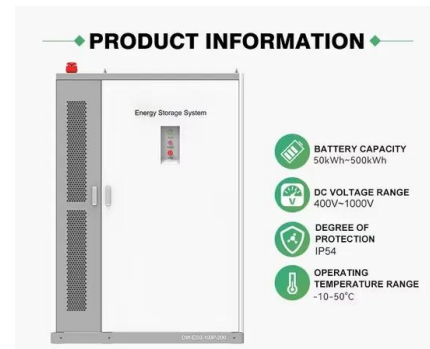

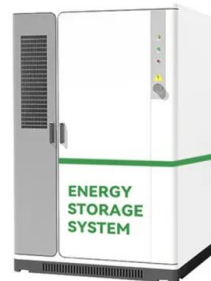

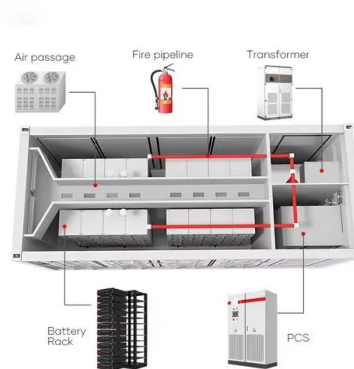
