- Usually a piece of cardboard or plastic is placed in between every two panels.

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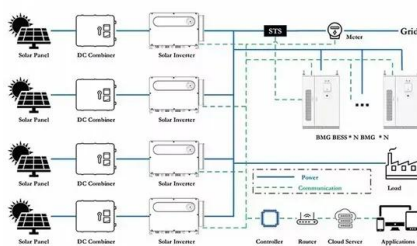

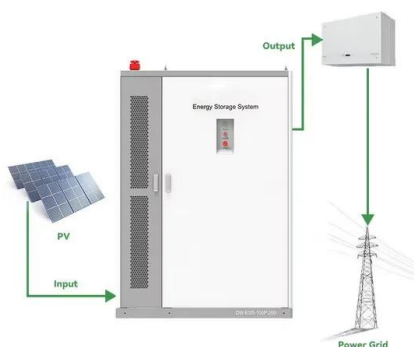
