Solar power station Baghdad



Overview

Where will Baghdad's solar power plant be built?

The project will be developed as a joint venture in Najaf city, located 160 km south of the capital, Baghdad. Construction firm PowerChina has also been awarded a contract to build a 250 MW solar power facility in the country.

Will Iraq build a solar power plant in Basrah?

Earlier this month, French oil major TotalEnergies invited ACWA Power to develop a 1-gigawatt solar power plant to supply electricity to the Basrah regional grid. In August 2021, Iraq signed a contract with PowerChina to build 2,000 MW solar plants in the country.

Will totalenergies build a solar power plant in Iraq?

French energy major TotalEnergies will build a 1-gigawatt solar power plant in Iraq as part of a cluster of contracts it was awarded in 2021 for an integrated project that entails a total investment of \$27 billion over 30 years.

Does Iraq have a solar power plant?

The contracts also cover a water intake project for injection into oil reservoirs. The solar power plant will be Iraq's first utility-scale solar power project. While the country has several other solar plans in the pipeline, the TotalEnergies project is the first to proceed to the implementation phase.

Why is Iraq building a solar power plant in 2021?

In August 2021, Iraq signed a contract with PowerChina to build 2,000 MW solar plants in the country. Prince Faisal bin Farhan, Saudi Arabia's foreign minister, highlighted the depth of relations between the two countries during his visit to Baghdad in February, saying that Iraq plays an essential role in strengthening stability in the region.

Will Iraq build a power plant in Kurdistan?

ERBIL, Kurdistan Region - Iraq's national investment commission on Sunday signed an investment license with French energy giant TotalEnergies to develop a power plant with a capacity of 1,000 megawatts south of the country. Haider Makkia, head of the commission, said during the inking.
