Is there a solar power plant in Sao Tome & Principe?

Also on the island of Príncipe, there are plans to develop a 4.5 MWp solar photovoltaic plant. Currently, the rate of renewable energy production in the energy mix in Sao Tome and Principe is 5% from the Contador hydroelectric plant with 1.9 MW.

How can Sao Tome and Principe improve economic growth?

Despite some improvements in education and access to healthcare, Sao Tome and Principe has much to do to decrease its high poverty rate, create jobs, and increase its economic growth.

Who is responsible for rehabilitating a thermal plant in Africa?

The rehabilitation plans are under the responsibility of UNIDO, UNDP and ETISP (Energy Transition and Institutional Support Programme) of the African Development Bank, which also includes two solar PV projects, technical strengthening and maintenance of the thermal plants.
