Overview

Nearly 80% of solar power installed in the Netherlands in 2017 was for small systems of less than 10 kW, a large part being rooftop Solar PV. Larger systems over 500 kW accounted for just 6.9% of the total. By the end of 2018 private residential rooftop systems had an installed capacity of 2,307 MW, businesses rooftop systems 1,662 MW whilst solar parks amounted to 444 MW. Residential Solar PV Capacity According to a report on behalf of the European Commission in 2015 the Netherlands had an estimated 1,086 MW of residential solar PV capacity with 232,000 residential solar PV prosumers in the country representing 3% of households. The average size of residential solar PV systems is estimated to be 4.69 kW moving to 2030. The technical potential for residential solar PV in the Netherlands is estimated at 13,945 MW. The payback time for residential Solar PV in the Netherlands is 9.7 years as of 2015. Are solar panels a good choice in the Netherlands?

The Netherlands has some 800 square kilometres of roofs free for solar panels, half of which are commercial properties or agricultural roofs. But not all roofs are suitable. Also, the weight of standard solar panels is often too high for the load-bearing capacity of the roof, or the panels are not desirable from an aesthetic point of view.

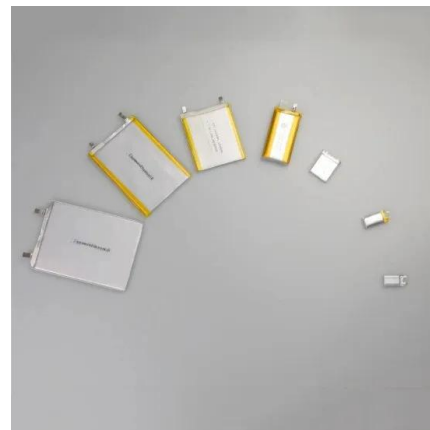
