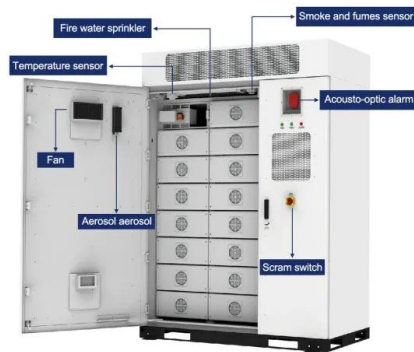
Varna Combined Cycle Power Plant, Bulgaria

The Republika power station (also known as TPP Republika) began operating in 1951. In 2007 it was said to be Europe's oldest functioning coal plant. The fifth generator (the only still running on coal) has undergone two reconstructions; the first in 2007, and the second in 2012, when an

earthquake caused the chimney to partially collapse.

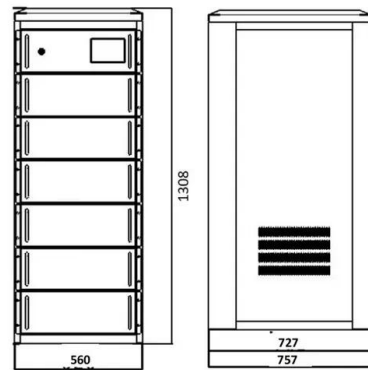

In July 2022, the Prime Minister and Environment Minister of Bulgaria toured the plant and found "mind-boggling violations". This was after years of



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
