Is Uzbekistan a scale solar country?

The currently operational Navoi 100 MW Scaling Solar 1 power plant became the first large-scale, competitively procured, and privately developed and operated renewable energy facility in the country.

Will Uzbekistan have two solar power plants?

In May 2021, Uzbekistan announced the winning bidder of the public-private partnerships (PPPs) for two separate solar power plants, each with a capacity

of 220 MW in Kattakurgan district of Samarkand region and Gallaorol district of Jizzakh region.

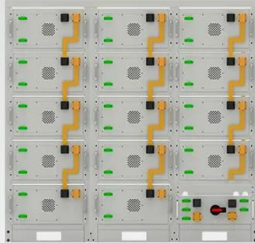
Does Uzbekistan have a 'green' energy system?
