Western Sahara cost of solar power



Overview

Researchers imagine it might be possible to transform the world's largest desert, the Sahara, into a giant solar farm, capable of meeting four times the world's current energy demand.

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With its vast expanse of unbroken sunlight, it's estimated that utilizing just 1.2% of this desert could theoretically power the entire world. According to Finnish researchers, a network of solar farms in the Sahara could significantly contribute to global energy needs and push humanity closer to net-zero emissions.

Covering just 1.2% of the Sahara with solar panels could generate enough electricity to power the entire world. Transforming the Sahara into a renewable energy powerhouse has captured the imagination of scientists and policymakers.

The cost reduction in solar panels follows what is known as 'Swanson's Law': the observation that the price of solar PV modules tends to drop 20 per cent for every doubling of cumulative .

The desert's vast landmass offers ample space for large-scale solar projects capable of generating significant amounts of electricity. Developing solar power in the Sahara could transform the region into a renewable energy hub, contributing to global efforts to reduce carbon emissions and mitigate climate change.

Morocco exploits land, air and sea in Western Sahara despite having no sovereignty over it. Western Sahara is connected to the Moroccan grid via the capital Laayoune. A new 400kV power connection is planned between Laayoune and Dakhla, and to Mauritania. Through this power-line, Morocco plans to export renewable energy to West Africa.
