Do solar storms hit the Earth?

They are the backbone of modern society: telecommunications, aviation, space-based technology, and the power grid. Most solar storms do not hit the Earth, for the same reason that most baseballs don't hit one particular person in the stands. But, when a storm does get here, it gets here fast.

How powerful are solar storms?

Based on magnetometer readings, auroral latitudes, and other fingerprints left behind by solar storms, scientists now believe that at least three storms in the

past hundred and fifty-odd years—the Carrington Event and others in 1872 and 1921—were roughly an order of magnitude more powerful.

How do we deal with severe solar storms?

Still, persuading people to implement safety measures is difficult, because severe solar storms are what people in emergency management sometimes call low-frequency, high-consequence events. Such events are emotionally, ethically, and pragmatically vexing, and we respond to them in curious and inconsistent ways.
